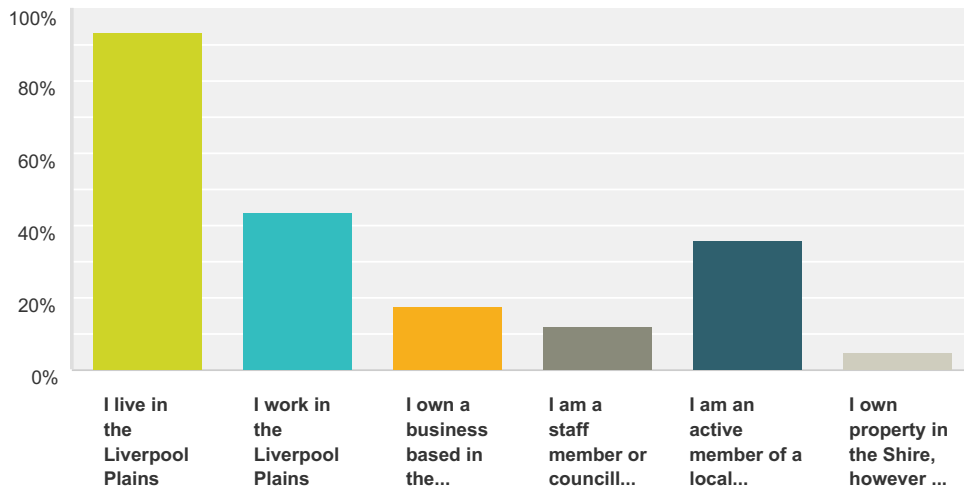


Q1 Which of the following best describes you? (tick more than one if appropriate)

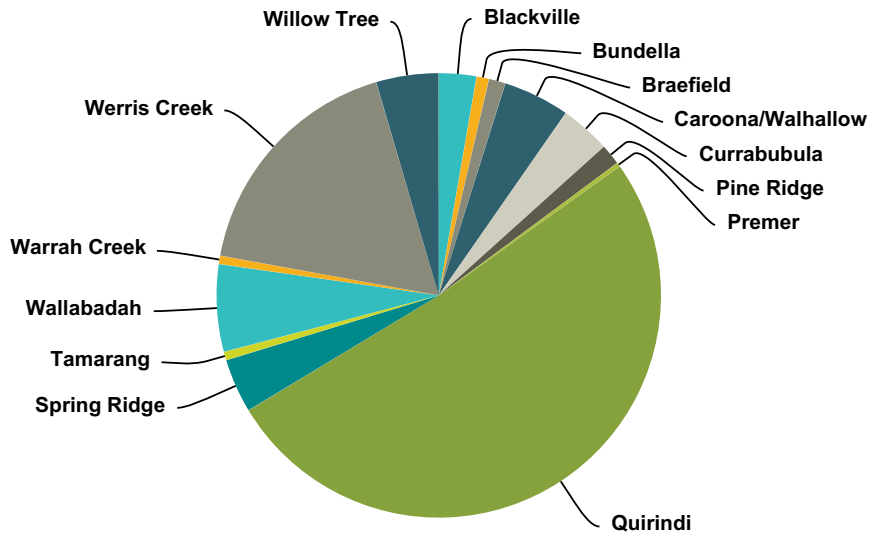

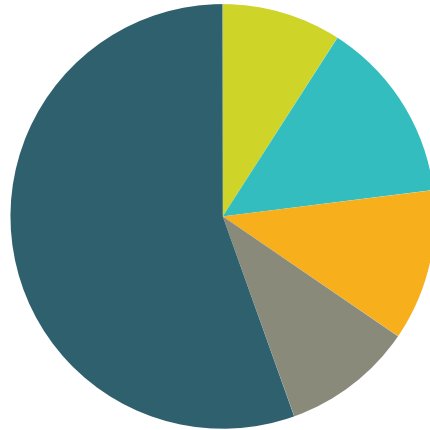

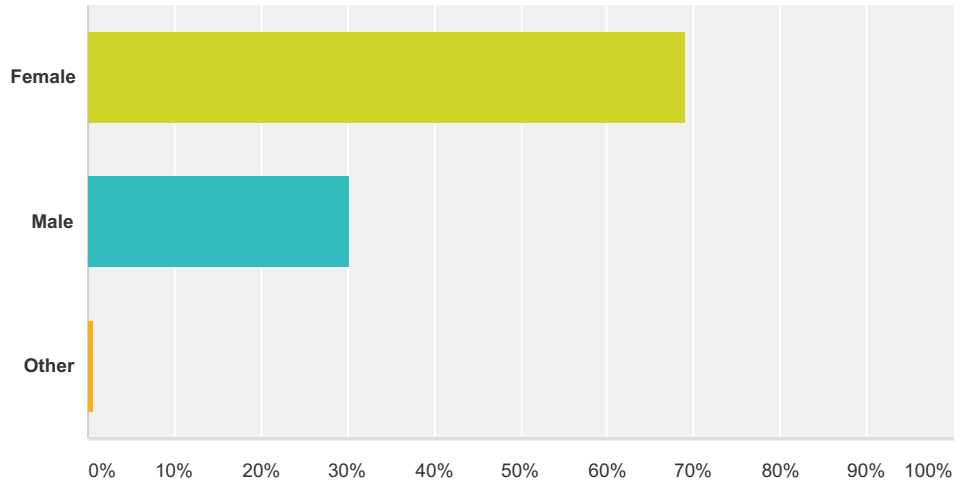

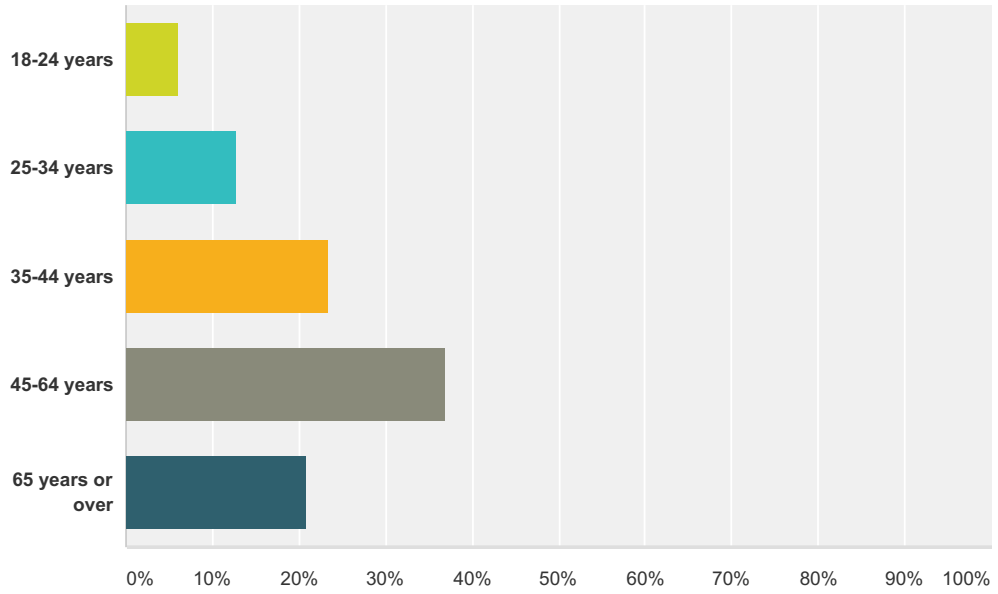

Q5 What is your age?

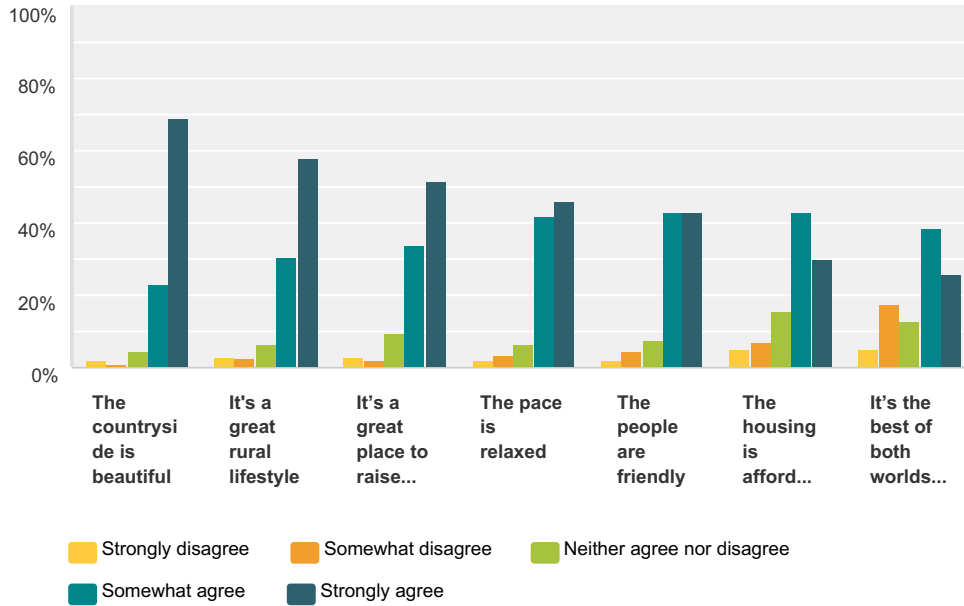

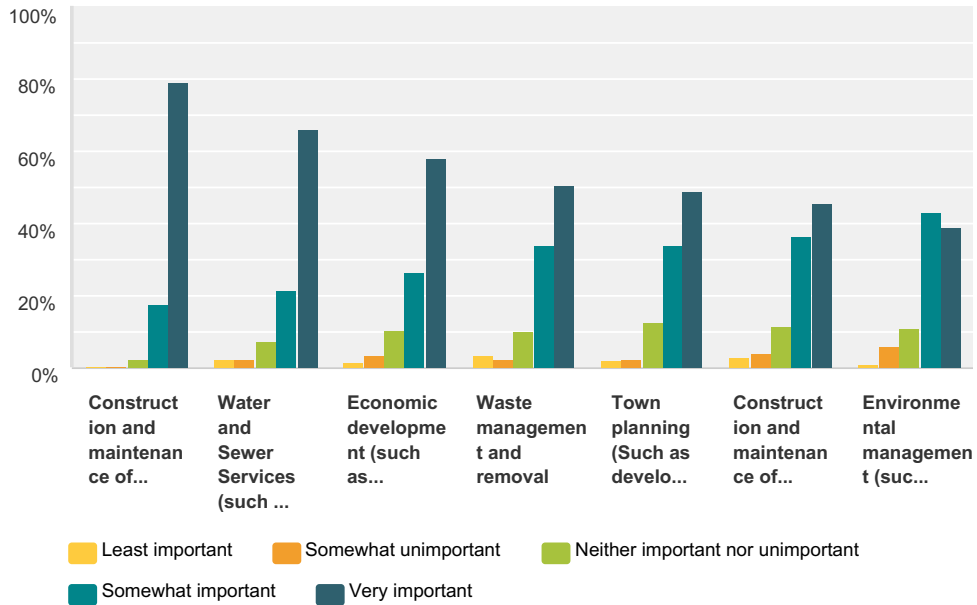

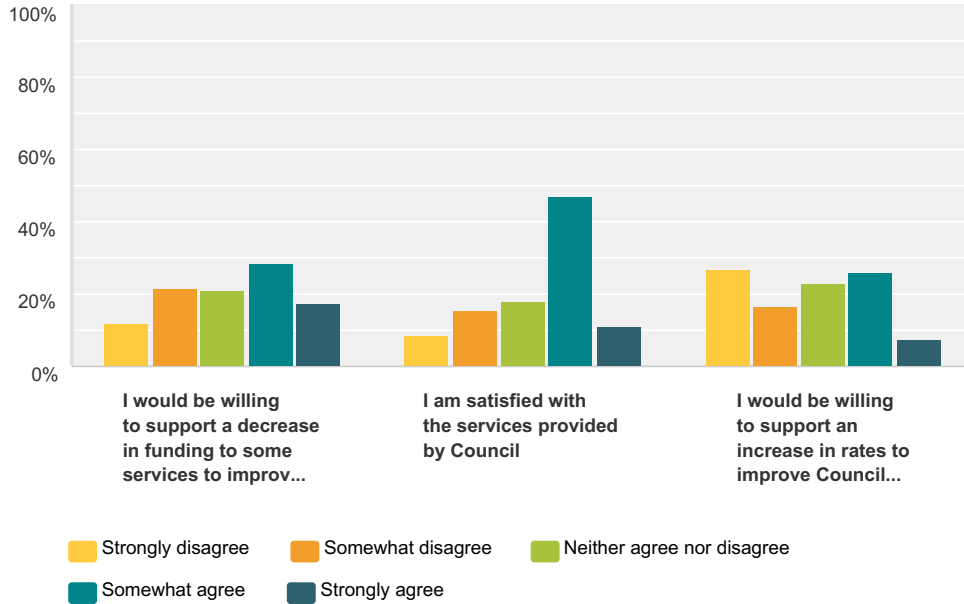

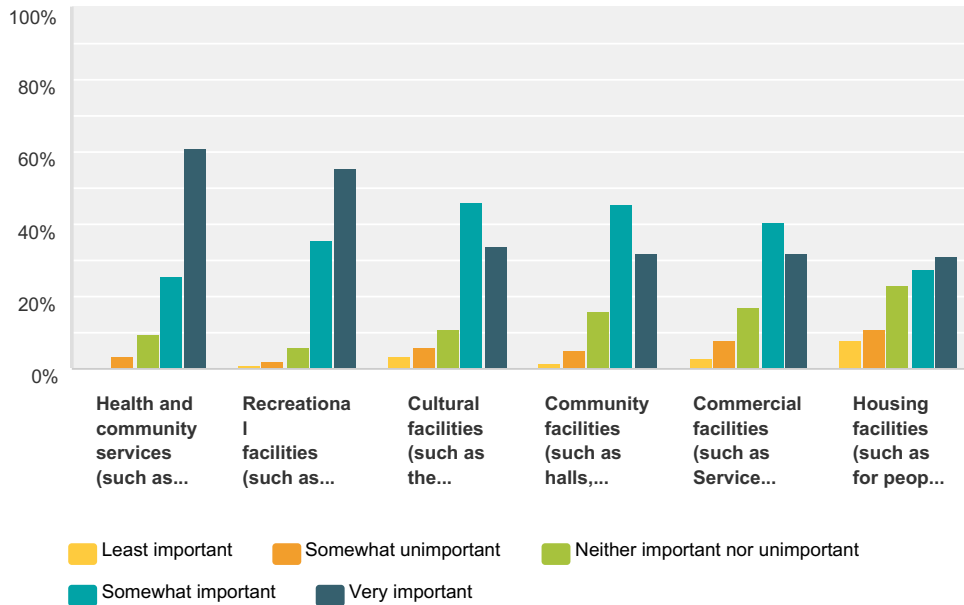

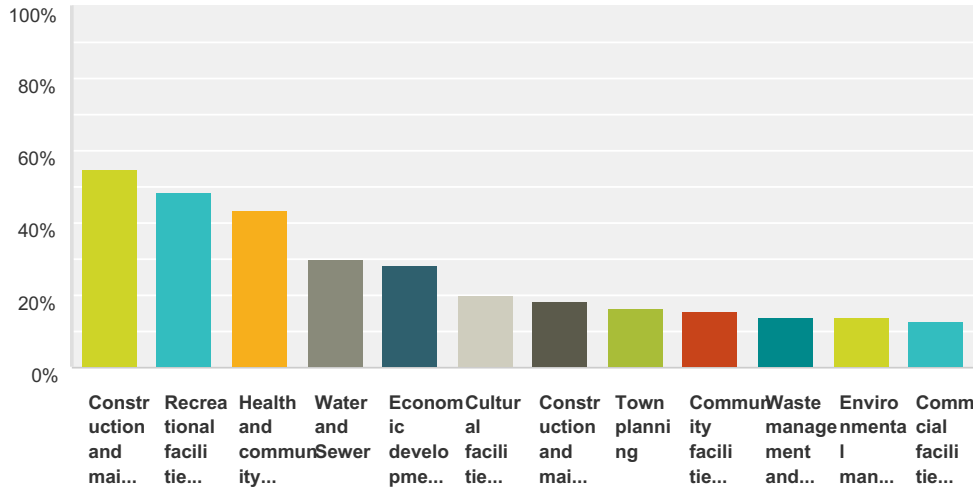

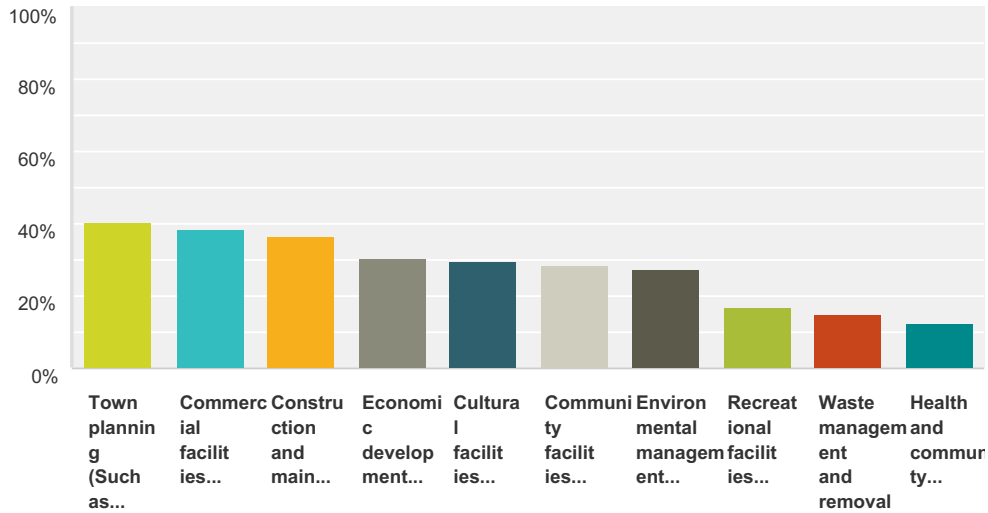

Q11 If additional funds were allocated to improve the roads in the Liverpool Plains, which of the following services or facilities should Council DECREASE the funding for? (select your top 3)

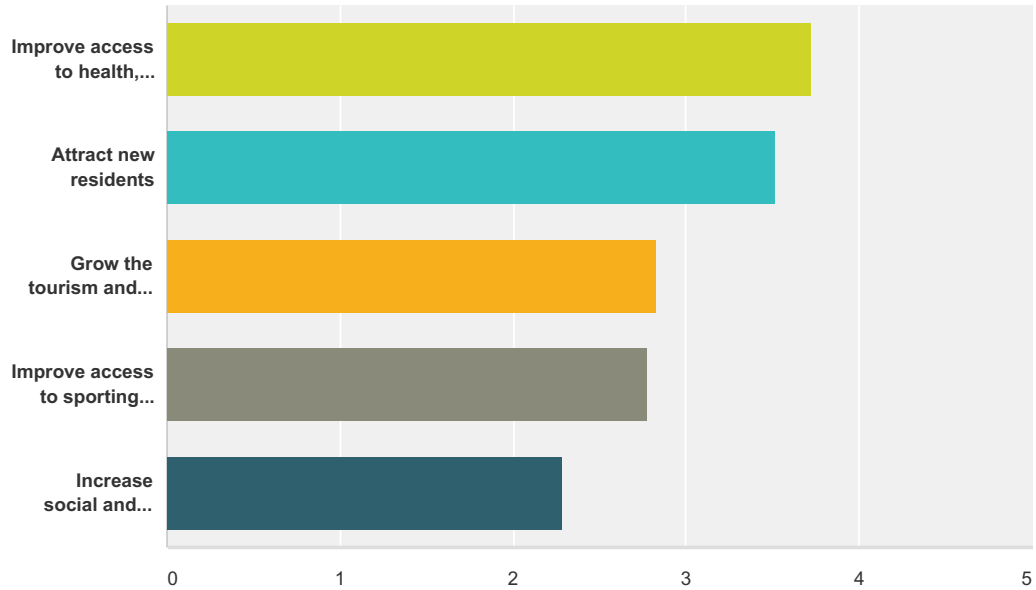

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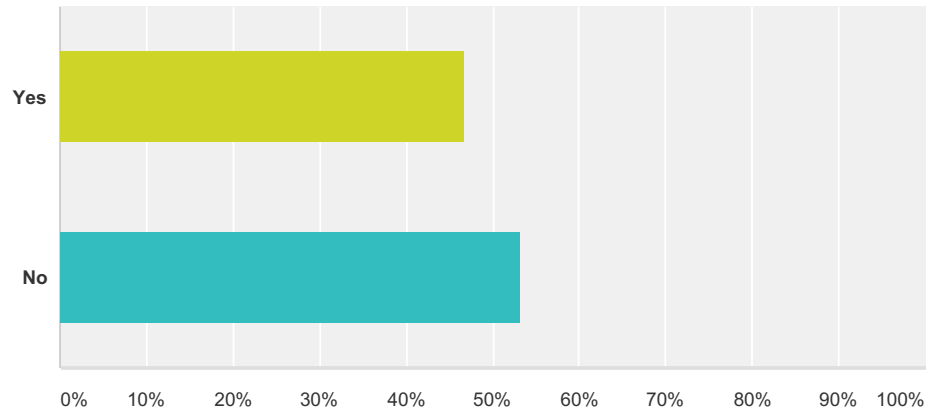
