



Liverpool Plains Youth Scholarship Scheme

GUIDE LINES FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE SCHEME

The Scheme

The Liverpool Plains Youth Scholarship Scheme has been established and funded by Liverpool Plains Shire Council to provide young people with funding support to pursue educational and employment training opportunities in art, music, the sciences, business, trades, sport and the like.

Who Can be Nominated

Individuals cannot apply themselves but can be nominated on forms made available for that purpose.

Persons nominated must be between 12-25 years of age and be a resident of the Liverpool Plains Shire, or be attending a School or College or be employed within the Shire.

The nominator will need to demonstrate how the beneficiary will:

- a) further their education or enhance their educational experience; or
- b) enrich their experience to make the nominee a better employee or to increase their employment prospects; or
- c) advance their personal attributes, development and leadership skills

Provision is made on the Nomination Form for the nominated person to respond to questions regarding their nomination.

Interviews

To assist the Committee to assess nominations, interviews may be necessary.

Reporting

Successful applicants will be required to submit an activity report either in person or in writing within four (4) weeks of completion of the activity. If a report is not submitted the Committee will refuse funding for any future requests made by the applicant.

Variation to Guidelines

The Committee reserves the right to vary the guidelines of the Scheme where it considers a nomination falls outside the scope of the scheme but is of outstanding merit.
